## Connected care expands to Express Clinic

Telehealth is not new to Excelsior Springs Hospital, as it has been used in the Emergency Department for several years. But thanks to new technology and grant funding, the hospital is now able to extend their telehealth program throughout the clinics of care established in the community. The Express Clinic will be the first in the network of care to utilize the technologies.

“Working with a vision for the future, bringing in telehealth to our system, we will be setting our community up for long term success in being able

to address individualized health needs,” stated Petisha Davis, Express Clinic Family Nurse Practitioner.

Patients coming in to see the physician at the Express Clinic can expect the same access, but delivered in a different way. Like normal, patients will check in with the attendant and then be taken to one of the two exam rooms with an in-person Care Provider. There you will be connected via video feed with the physician who will appear on

the video screen. The physician will be able to see then act as the arms and hands, using the connected medical tools to examine you. At the same time the physician is able to see on the screen what the in-person provider is seeing, and is able to provide prompt feedback on what is needed for treatment.

"Telehealth will help to reduce wait times and allow our physicians to take care of as many people as possible," said Davis. "If there is a specialist

that is needed, one could be remoted in directly, giving the patient immediate access to the specialist in need, saving valuable time."

While this is just the first in many expansions to the telehealth program, citizens of the Excelsior Springs area can expect to experience quicker, more direct access to the healthcare system they need, in a safe and efficient manner. ## Golf Ball Drop Rules

The Golf Ball Drop will take place on Friday, June 4, 2021 at the Excelsior Springs Golf Course, weather, and circumstances permitting. Participants may enter more than once. After purchase, participants will receive a numbered ticket. All purchased golf balls will be individually numbered based on the ticket number that corresponds with their individually numbered golf ball. Purchasers must be 21 years old or older at the time of purchase. All golf ball purchases are final and non-refundable.

By entering the Golf Ball Drop, the purchaser acknowledges that he or she is aware of, and agrees to abide by, the Golf Ball Drop Rules. Odds of winning depend on the number of golf balls sold, as well as where they land when dropped. In one, over the top-moment, thousands of individually numbered golf balls will rain down, quickly filling the hole. The nine participants whose numbered golf balls go into the hole or fall closest to the hole will win cash prizes.
